## Venue Available For Hire

### We hire halls out for weddings, birthdays and christenings at very competitive prices

The Liberty Hall has a maximum capacity of 250 people and has stage facilities and its own well stocked Liberty Bar. This Hall is popular for stage shows, parties and dinner dances. Customers of the Liberty Hall have use of the Foyer and the Foyer Bar can also be made available upon request.

The Cinque Port Hall is licensed for 100 people and is a favourite venue for Children's parties and smaller celebrations. Hirers of this hall have use of the Oyster Bar.

We also have two Meeting Rooms which have a capacity of 40 people each.

The Community Centre has easy disabled access to all areas with designated parking spaces and disabled toilet, the Liberty Hall also benefits from a hearing loop. Other facilities offered include a large car park, three licensed bars, fully equipped kitchen, baby changing facilities and hot drinks vending machine. We can also arrange stage sound and lighting hire.

The Oyster Bar, Foyer Bar and Liberty Bar all offer a wide selection of drinks at extremely competitive prices. For large functions, we would be happy to supply Wine Lists to meet your specific tastes and budgets.
